

NAME

CURLOPT_VERBOSE – set verbose mode on/off

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_VERBOSE, long onoff);
```

DESCRIPTION

Set the *onoff* parameter to 1 to make the library display a lot of verbose information about its operations on this *handle*. Very useful for libcurl and/or protocol debugging and understanding. The verbose information will be sent to stderr, or the stream set with *CURLOPT_STDERR*(3).

You hardly ever want this set in production use, you will almost always want this when you debug/report problems.

To also get all the protocol data sent and received, consider using the *CURLOPT_DEBUGFUNCTION*(3).

DEFAULT

0, meaning disabled.

RETURN VALUE

Returns CURLE_OK.
